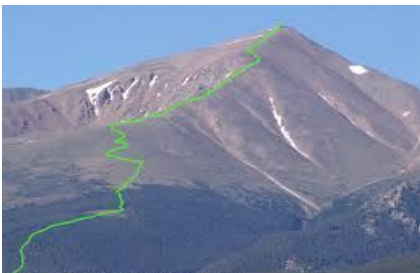


Photo #2: A closer look at the Northeast Ridge.
